## **Before Mass**

- Liturgical colour is White
- Altar of Repose is prepared as required
- The Tabernacle should be entirely empty and open
- Extinguish the Sanctuary Lamp
- Holy Oils prepared
- Enough hosts to be consecrated at this Mass to also cover communion on Good Friday.
- Bowl, jug and towels for washing of feet.
- Extra items for clergy to wash hands after feet washing
- Humeral Veil
- Bells for Gloria only
